If Lloyd Park or Willow Lodge have a positive case of Covid- 19, either staff or resident, she will not enter that home unless it is vital. Whilst visiting the homes she will ensure she socially distances from residents and only enters bedrooms where necessary. If Heatherwood have a positive Covid-19 test result she won't move between the other 2 homes. For that period of time her audits will be completed remotely. Where it is possible she will complete more than one audit at a time on one visit thus to reduce the number of times she is visiting each home. All office staff have had both vaccinations against Covid-19.
