4. What kind of things did you do as a kid that got you into trouble at home or school?

5. Growing up what did you want to be?

6. Outside of the family, what was the very first job you had that you got paid for?

7. How did you meet Dad? (Grandpa) How did he ask you to marry him?

8. What is the hardest thing that you ever had to do in your life?

9. What is the greatest compliment that you have ever received?

10. What is one thing you still want to do that you have never done? (What is still on your "Bucket List?") Bonus Question: If your Mom's answer on any question leaves you wanting to know more, simple ask: Mom can you please tell us more about that? thoughts by centering on two words, privilege and HOPE. It is a privilege to serve Christ. Christ is HOPE. Out of that sense of privilege comes a responsibility to engage with others who have the heart to join Him where He is working. Sharing what He has called me to do brings HOPE to others as they see Christ at work in and through Father & Son Connection and Pure Adventure events. Because of you, I GET to serve as a missionary.
