# Thank you for choosing Noosa Lions FC as your Club in 2021. <u>REGISTRATION</u>

All players and coaches must register at <u>www.playfootball.com.au</u>. If you were a registered player last year then you use your existing log in. New players will need to create an account. You can register the whole family under the one account.

Online registration opens on January 4th, 2021. Players must register online prior to attending information days or paying fees at the office. Players can register and pay online <u>without</u> the need to attend the information days at the club. You will only be <u>required</u> to attend our Information day if you wish to use Pay Smart and Fair Play Vouchers or choose your team allocation (mini roos only u6-u11).

**Birth Certificate/Identification –** all <u>new</u> players are required to provide Birth Certificate (for juniors) or photo identification (for seniors). These can be sighted at Sign-On days or emailed to <u>secretary@noosalionsfc.com</u>

**International Clearance** – If you are new to Noosa Lions, are registering for Under 10 and above, are not an Australian Citizen or your last registration was overseas, you will need International clearance. This can be a lengthy process so please email <u>treasurer@noosalionsfc.com</u> ASAP after registering for more information. Please note this is a FIFA requirement, and is not something that Noosa Lions, Football Queensland or Football Federation of Australia have any jurisdiction over.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

Registration does not guarantee a place in a team. We will endeavour to place everyone in a team however it is not always possible therefore recommend registering as early as possible.

When registering for Noosa Lions FC you are agreeing to abide by our Code of Conduct and the FFA Code of Conduct. Respect for players, coaches and officials is of the utmost importance. ## 2021 FEES

Registration Fees for 2021 are set out below. **NOTE:** No player can join the 2021 competition unless full fees have been paid or a Paysmart agreement has been entered into.

**Cancellations –** Cancelling a paid and active registration may incur a 5% admin fee. Once a player has taken the field in a game your registration fee cannot be refunded (only exceptions are season ending injuries in first 6 weeks) \*Please note special refund conditions may apply if the 2021 season is affected by Covid-19 restrictions which will be dictated by FQ/FFA and QLD Health Directives\*

**Training Shirts are included** in this fee and will be available at the end of March. Players are required to only wear 2021 training shirts during the 2021 season

**Paysmart** – is a payment plan service and is available for those not able to pay full fees up front. We do not offer inhouse payment plans. Paysmart can be used for full fees or part fees. To use Paysmart you will need to attend sign on to complete the appropriate paperwork. You will need to provide



your bank account name, BSB, and account number. Please attend a sign on day to complete the application.

**Fair Play Vouchers** – (formally Get Started) is a Queensland Government support programme to assist in the affordability of sporting club fees for children u18. At Club – payments can be made at the club during sign on day or office hours. Credit card payments will incur a small fee.

## TEAM ALLOCATION

- Players can only attend team allocation sessions if they are registered for 2021 at <u>www.playfootball.com</u>. You do not have to be paid but must be registered.
- All players are encouraged to play in their own age group as set out in the SCF Player Age Policy. Players will only be able to register in their own age group on Playfootball.com.au; however, consideration will be given to requests to play outside of this age group. Any team preference requests must be submitted in person at the information day only.
- We are open to requests for team allocation and will aim to facilitate where possible.
- The Committee will be allocating players to teams, based on those registered at the time, immediately after the main sign on day Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> February. Team preferences after 8th February will only be considered if already formed teams are not affected.

**Game venues**: vary depending on team/division/draw. All draws are determined by Sunshine Coast Football. Games/carnivals may be held at any club within SCF.

**Home games at Girraween-** approximately half your games will be at our home fields. <u>Please note</u> we are a non-smoking venue and no dogs are allowed.

Updates for Noosa Lions FC only are also found on our Facebook site and website. Training cancellations due to the weather will usually be on Facebook by 2pm on the training day (late closures can occur on occasion during training sessions)

**Player insurance** is provided by Football Queensland and the cost is included in the FQ component of player fees. If injured, players must log on at <u>www.footballqueensland.com.au</u> to lodge a claim within 90 days. All injuries must be reported to the club and we will need to sign off on the claim. As the cover is limited, we recommend getting additional cover of your own or you can extend your coverage with Football Queensland's provider.

**Can my child play in a team with a friend?** We do our best to place players with friends where possible in the mini roo age groups (U6-U11). The exception to this is U10 and U11 Kangaroo's which are selected teams. Requests must be made at sign on days. Preference is given to returning players but only if registered by 8<sup>th</sup> February. Requests will be considered for division 2 competitive teams but not guaranteed.

**Will all teams have a paid coach?** Normally not. 90% of our teams will be coached by a parent volunteer. Parents will receive support and training from our Technical Director.

**Do I have to pay my fees in full when I register?** No, you don't. You can register and select pay at club and then pay at our sign on days. Or you can use Paysmart to pay off the fees in instalments. Paysmart forms are available in the office or can be emailed to you.

Where will my game be played? Draws for all ages are controlled by Sunshine Coast Football and can be viewed on their website <u>www.sunshinecoastfootball.com</u> or the Game Day app. Draws may not be posted till 1 week before the first game and at the start of the season may only have a few weeks in advance. Please be patient because at the beginning of the season there can be lots of changes.

**Can my child play up an age group?** We encourage players to play in their own age group. If turning 9 in 2021 you are under 9. Consideration may be given depending upon ability, available positions, school friendships etc. No guarantee is made for any players to play up.
