

## **NOOSA LIONS FOOTBALL CLUB** INFORMATION PACK



### Registration

All players and coaches must register at www.playfootball.com.au. If you were a registered player last year then you use your existing log in. New players will need to create an account. You can register the whole family under the one account.

Online registration opens on January 9th, 2023.

Birth Certificate/Identification - all new players are required to provide Birth Certificate (for juniors) or photo identification (for seniors). These can be sighted at Sign-On days or emailed to secretary@noosalionsfc.com

International Clearance - If you are new to Noosa Lions and are not an Australian Citizen or your last registration was overseas, you will need International clearance (only applies to u10 and up). This can be a lengthy process so please email treasurer@noosalionsfc.com ASAP after registering. Please note this is a FIFA requirement, and is not something that Noosa Lions, Football Queensland or Football Australia have any jurisdiction over

### PLEASE NOTE:

Registration does not guarantee a place in a team. All 2022 Noosa Lions players are guaranteed a place in a team if registered by 15th January. We will endeavour to place everyone in a team however it is not always possible therefore recommend registering as early as possible





### 2023 Registration Fees

Fees for 2023 are set out below. NOTE: No player can join the 2023 competition unless full fees have been paid or a Paysmart agreement has been entered into.

Cancellations – Cancelling a paid and active registration will incur a 5% admin fee. Once a player has taken the field in a game or training your FQ registration fee cannot be refunded (only exceptions are season ending injuries in first 6 weeks)

Training Shirts are included in this fee and will be available at the end of March. Players are required to only wear 2023 training shirts during the 2023 season

### **TEAM ALLOCATIONS**

- Players can only attend Trial sessions if they are registered for 2023 at www.playfootball.com and Squadi.
- All players are encouraged to play in their own age group as set out in the SCF Player Age Policy. Players will only be able to register in their own age group on Playfootball.com.au. Consideration may be given for playing up in mini roos however this is not guarenteed. Football Qld will have strict parameters around the u13 and u14 age groups and playing up at this stage will not be considered.
- Any team preference requests for ages u6 u9 must be submitted in person at the information day only.
- The Committee will be allocating players to teams, based on those registered at the time, immediately after the main sign on day Saturday 28th January. Team preferences after 2nd February will only be considered if already formed teams are not affected.



**Fixtures** - fixture information is available on Sunshine Coast Football website. Sunshine Coast - Football Queensland. Fixtures are expected to start on 10th March 2023 (subject ot change)

**Game venues** - vary depending on team/division/draw. All draws are determined by Sunshine Coast Football. Games/carnivals may be held at any club within SCF.

**Home games at Girraween**- approximately half your games will be at our home fields. Please note we are a non-smoking venue and no dogs are allowed.



FAQS

Can my child play in a team with a friend? We do our best to place players with friends where possible in the mini roos age groups (u6-u12). The exception to this is U110, U11 and U12 Kangaroo's which are selected teams. Requests must be made at sign on days. Preference is given to returning players but only if registered by 29th January. Football Queensland will have strict parameters for the u13 and u14 age groups and playing up at this stage will not be considered.

Will all teams have a paid coach? No.90% of our teams will be coached by a parent volunteer. Parents will receive support and training from our Technical Director.

**Do I have to pay my fees in full when I register?** No you don't. You can register and select pay at club and then pay at our sign on days. Or you can use Paysmart to pay off the fees in instalments. Paysmart forms are available in the office or can be emailed to you.

Where will my game be played? Draws for all ages are controlled by Sunshine Coast Football and can be viewed on their website Sunshine Coast - Football Queensland or the Game Day app. Draws may not be posted till 1 week before the first game and at the start of the season may only have a few weeks in advance.

Can my child play up an age group? We encourage players to play in their own age group. If turning 9 in 2023 you are under 9. Consideration may be given depending upon ability, available positions, school friendships etc. No guarantee is made for any player to play up.


