

A Few Statistics

- In 2021, there were 2.3 million separated families in the UK, with 3.6 million children
- Almost half of children are growing up outside the nuclear family
- 44% of babies born at start of century did not live with both biological parents their entire children
- Every year, approximately 280,000 children have parents who separate




The main needs of children when parents separate.

















Children are affected when families separate. Who, in Government, is responsible for their needs?
