Hall-keeper's Report	 Isla had circulated her bookings and financial report and this was noted. Amy Gornall was introduced as the new hall caretaker. She gave us a rundown on her thoughts/experience of managing her job as caretaker. She had various issues which were discussed such as finding the 3rd fire alarm tricky to test. (Robert is to check all of them), she wasn't satisfied that the cleaners were doing a very good job. Amy to discuss with Isla regarding being notified properly when the cleaners are coming to clean. And also to report any issues/faults to Isla. There is the continuing problem with users leaving dirty tea towels in the sink. There is a new green bin from PKCo. Ced has turned off underfloor heating. Electricity use in the hall. The price hike in electricity is becoming a real issue for the future of the hall. Ced stated that the monthly usage of electricity was £700 and this is obviously unsustainable. Users have been forgetting to leave things as they found them & heating has been left on for considerable periods of time. As well as these new increases, it is imperative that we do the following: 1) Double the rent . Gillian is to look into other local hall rates for comparison 2) Make hall users aware of the situation by sending out a Facebook message. 3) Charge non-compliant users a surcharge if they don't switch off lights but especially the heating in the hall & the meeting room. Robert & Isla are working on getting T&C forms signed by users. The general situation regarding electricity was discussed & it was felt that the oil-filled radiators in the meeting room should be removed for the summer as they were energy inefficient. The large heaters in the hall came under scrutiny as they used a lot of energy this is an ongoing issue that needs attention.
