Trustees Report and Annual Accounts	Treasurer apologised for not getting Financial Report in time for meeting. Noted that Coffee morning generated over £3,500 before expenses. The bank balance of ca £25k as of March 2019 did not reflect grants received. Treasurer undertook to provide a full report for the next meeting. It was agreed this final meeting would be required to approve the 2018-19 accounts and the closing accounts for the Village Hall and to approve the winding up of the Association. The closing accounts would be prepared to December 31st2019. Tanya has kept a good control over the hall rental debtors. Rental income is approx. £10,000 per annum. The hire charge for regular users has remained static but there is a slight increase for occasional users.

Update on Reorganisatio n of the Charity to a SCIO	Ced outlined the existing situation re SCIO – Two-tier SCIO: membership & Board of Trustees. John Cassells is the solicitor who is dealing with the trustees & reorganisation into a SCIO. He was in attendance and updated the meeting on progress with the reorganisation of the charity. The invoice and expenses incurred by the Trustees have been settled, and the Trustees (Link Asset Services) have approved the winding up of the Association and the transfer of the assets to the SCIO, Arngask Hall. The purchase of the Schoolhouse has been completed & the title has been transferred to SCIO. We are in the process of title registration. Land register is consolidating title into hopefully one title in SCIO's name.	

Motion to Wind Up SC 027474	The motion to wind up the Village Hall charity whilst approved in principle will await formal approval until the final Annual Report and Accounts have been presented and approved.	
Plans to Convert Schoolhouse	Ced described with the aid of drawings the work proposed to bring the Schoolhouse into community use. Planning consent for change of use has been received and Building Warrant applied for. Likely to be a need for fire protection and alarms system. There has been essential repair and maintenance work carried out to make the building wind and water tight and remove timber decay and damp problems. Fund raising will be required to complete the conversion but at this stage costs were not known. Likely timescale for work is February March 2020.
