Property Report	 John Easton – a qualified electrician was employed to do an electrical assessment. He presented a report but then never turned up to four subsequent meetings which were organised. He was dismissed. 20th February – John Allison, electrician looked over the issues. The plugs above the sink need to be removed immediately & resited. Emergency Lighting – there are approx. 10 of these. They need to be replaced with LED lighting which is more cost effective to run. John Allison charges per hour & the materials are sold on at cost. This work was approved. Other items which are not so pressing can be done at a later date. Kareen has put hazardous cleaning liquids in a locked cupboard & disposed of others. AFF extinguishers are £50.00 + VAT each. At the moment we are at a minimum level. It was decided to leave the present extinguishers as they are for the time being. John Armstrong does a monthly inspection at present. Keys- There are too many keys in circulation. John will employ a locksmith to come & fit a new lock and provide uncopiable keys.
