- \* 3 year programme
- \* Integrated degree apprenticeship
- \* JNC recognition and professional status

- \* Applied Theory to practice to support development
- \* Rich learning environment with apprentices from across England
- \* Residential and then online learning 1 day per week
- \* 1000 hours work based practice 840 + 160 alternative



## **KEY FACTS**

Duration: 36 months + up to 6 months for the End Point Assessment (EPA)

Start Date: September each academic year

Delivery: week long residential each year (September) to Online learning and teaching across a range of modules

Learning: practice to theory to practice development cycle



# COSTS

Apprenticeship Cost £20,000 (£1100)

Levy Funding £20,000

Non-Levy (5%) £1,100

Employers will also need to cover:
