Who are the North Penn S Gaugers:

The North Penn S Gauger are a diverse group of S Gauge enthusiasts formed in 1998. Our interests range from American Flyer through Modern S scale equipment. Our membership is primarily from Southeastern Pennsylvania, but anyone interested in S Gauge trains is encouraged to join. We also operate a portable S gauge layout for the enjoyment and education of the public about several a year. Please consult our events schedule on our website.

We hold membership meetings once a month at our club house, located at Advanced Living Communities, 1292 Allentown Rd, Lansdale, PA 19446 and work sessions as needed to maintain or update the layout. At these sessions our members show off or teach their skills to other club members. Many of our members are also members of The National Association of S Gaugers (NASG), the Train Collectors Association (TCA) and other national model railroad organizations.

Modular Layout

Modular construction of our portable layout allows our display layout to vary in size to fit any area form 10 x 14 feet to 24 x 34 feet. Our American Models track and selectable power controls allow operation of our trains to run in conventional AC powered through DCC controlled equipment. The large size of our portable layout allows members who do not have a personal layout, or are limited to a small layout the opportunity to operate on a large scenic layout.



The club owns the layout and all power controls. The maintenance and updating of the layout are divided into committees. Members are encouraged to be active on one or more committees. Whether you enjoy nostalgic American Flyer or modern Hi-Rail equipment you can run it on our layout. While members usually bring their own trains to run, you do not need to own trains to participate. The Club owns trains that the members can operate.

Why S Gauge?

S gauge is considered the ideal size. It is larger than HO for easier operation and greater visual detail, but smaller O gauge for greater utilization of layout space.

The North Penn S Gaugers are proud to say that their club has been invited to exhibit their portable modular layout at numerous venues including Greenberg Train Shows, NASG Conventions, libraries, retirement communities and local train shows.
