

PRAYING WITH JESUS IN THE GOSPEL

The Lord is here. His Spirit is with us

Let us mute: Jesus' baptism in the Jordan. Jesus has no need of the repentance offered in John's baptism but he chooses to get into the waters of the Jordan with every one anyway. He does what is always does: gets in there with us, identifies with us. God's response as he sees Jesus in there with everyone: that's my boy. I am well pleased with you.

The same Jesus is with you now. Has chosen to get into your waters, is asking you to hear God saying to him and also to you ... that's my girl, that's my boy. I am well pleased with you.

Luke 3:15-16, 21-22

The people were filled with expectation, and all were asking in their hearts whether John might be the Christ. John answered them all, saying, "I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."

After all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."
