Albacete where some young professionals and one head nurse took time to talk to us after worship, sharing their big heart for missions. Our last leg of deputation in Negros Occidental was at New Hope Baptist Church of Silay with Pastor Abraham Gabinera and First Baptist Church of Central Hawaiian with Pastor Frank Tingson. How we desire that we could visit more churches in Negros, but the limited time we've had were full of blessings and rich experience seeing the lives of our fellow pastors and workers laboring hard for the glory of the Lord.

After the 2nd National Missions Summit at Tagum City, we spent this whole month of August in our own hometown at Iloilo. Worshipping together with our parents at Doane Baptist Church which is our sending church. We've had our physical exams conducted at West Visayas Medical Hospital for HIV test, PPD and TB test, and StatLab for our Diagnostics and Lab tests. All the tests are required for a Certification for fit to work which is essential to comply for missions work in PNG. We thank PABWE and all the supporting churches and individuals for being so generous and kind.

On the 2nd & 3rd Sundays of August we are at Cabatuan Fundamental Baptist Church and Fundamental Baptist Church of Dingle. There we met and conversed with two Nurses and a Seaman who responded to the challenge and have expressed their willingness to engage in missions. We were amazed on how the Lord preserved our health all throughout our Deputation work, despite rain and weather disturbances. God showered us His blessings and covered us with His great love and protection. There are moments that the enemy tried to discourage us. Countless times he tried to put clouds of doubt in our mind, make us feel afraid of what lies ahead in the future. Waiting seems to be the hardest part... your patience, faith and trust will surely be tested. But in those moments that we feel weak and resources are depleted, we take comfort in recalling how God sustained us from the very beginning of this journey. How He kept our feet from stumbling, and reminded us that He is our source of strength and provision. There is joy in serving Jesus! May we be found always faithful in the service of the King.
