During the month of June, we will publish a list of items we need in the worship folder. Please help us out by donating these items for our trip.

led us to this summer in Guatemala. Please join us as we seek God's guidance for this trip and for our direction as a church. We are always looking to Him for guidance with each day, month, and year in our local community, state, and around the World.



God has called us to shine His light in all these places. Thank you for helping us to shine July 1st - 8th in Guatemala!


