

From your Pastor's heart.....

Here we are nearing the end of May and approaching the beginning of June, on the brink of summer 2023, and we find ourselves almost equally situated between Mother's Day on May 14th and Father's Day on June 18th. It reminds me of just how important families are to the Kingdom of God.

The simple fact that Jesus' favorite term of reference for God was "Father," even to the point that when He taught is to pray in Matthew 6, He said, "In this manner therefore pray, 'Our Father in heaven." And you've got to love the fact that Jesus had a "mother" named Mary that he made sure was taken care of by John after He was gone. And the fact that there are 43 recorded references to "the Son of God" in the New Testament, and the term "brother" is used 115 times in the New Testament.

Add to all of that the fact that when Jesus called the twelve who would follow Him for three and a half years in ministry, he called two sets of brothers who were fishermen – James and John, and Peter and Andrew. And three of Jesus' closet followers were a pair of sisters named Mary and Martha, along with their brother Lazarus. All of that says to me that you and your family matter more than you will ever know to our God.

This past weekend I had the privilege of sharing in a celebration of life service in Owen County, Kentucky. I've spent a lot of time with a number of families through the years I've served in the ministry, but I was both impressed and downright humbled by what I experienced. This massive family had not all been together in a long time because of how scattered they had become through the years. And to be honest, most of the kids had probably grown so much over time that I'd personally need name tags to remember them all. But they seemed to pick-up right where they'd left off the last time they were together, without so much as skipping a beat.


My command is this:
