UJK - ACCOMMODATION

Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce provides student housing in five dormitories: **Asystent**, **Fama**, **Łącznik**, **Melodia**, and **Odyseya**. All of the dormitories are within a few steps from each other in the town centre. UJK is not confined to a single campus, with school facilities scattered throughout the city.

Our dorms offer:

- 24-hour security on-site
- Single or double rooms available with a private kitchenette
- and bathroom
- Furnished with: bed, wardrobe, table, chairs, fridge, electric
- cooker, and microwave
- Also included: bedding and phone
- Amenities in the building: laundry room, common room



The university's various buildings, hospitals, dormitories, laboratories, clinics, teaching facilities, and library are all easily accessible by public transportation.

In order to be considered for acceptance, applicants must be above 18 years old and provide:

One subject of choice:

Biology (Higher or Standard level)
OR
Chemistry (Higher or Standard level)

Physics (Higher or Standard level)
OR
Math (Higher or Standard level)

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS TO PROVIDE FOR ADMISSION:

A completed application form

A letter of motivation (instructions & samples)

A Health questionnaire signed by a physician stating the applicant is fit for medical studies, with a copy of vaccination records for the Hepatitis B (HBV) and Covid-19

Vaccine against Hepatitis B is mandatory. In exceptional cases, individual doses can be taken later. If you have any doubts, please contact us.

Vaccine against COVID-19 is strongly recommended.

NOTE: Each document must be translated into English. The translation must be done by an English translator accredited by the government of the country of issue of the document(s) or a sworn translator from the EU (if there is a sworn translator institution in your country)

Recruitment for MD Program in English at the Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce (UJK) is conducted by Owl-Med. Healthcare education. Owl-Med. Healthcare education is the official partner of the UJK in the recruitment process for MD Program in English

Owl-Med provides authorized admission aid to Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce and supplies a number of additional post-admission services, such as:

- **Airport reception**

Airport pick-up service and transfer to accommodation

- **Recognition of diplomas**

Assistance in the process of education documents recognition conducted by a province education superintendent in Poland

- **Legalization of stay**

Assistance in the legalization of stay in Poland (help in collecting all the required documents and representing a student before the immigration department)

Q&A ON VISA REQUIREMENTS

If you need a visa, you can get it at the Polish embassy in your country. Addresses and contact details of consulates and Embassies in your country can be found [here](#).

Note: To obtain visa you have to prove that you have enough money for living in Poland - with the calculation of approximately 190\$ / month + accommodation expenses + ticket for the return trip to your home country (approximately 680 \$). Please be informed that some embassies may also require to pay for at least one semester of studies. E.g. let's say your accommodation will cost 175\$ / months, thus to obtain visa for one year you have to have:

$(190\$ + 175\$) \times 12 \text{ months} + 680\$ \approx 5060\$$

Please note the university only provides Admission Letter required by the embassy. The university does not help with visa procedures and other formalities connected with it. If you need assistance, we recommend you to contact our Official Recruitment Agency - Owl-Med: dima@owl-med.com
