

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE M.D. PROGRAM IN 20 MINUTES?



Register online at our recruitment system. PRE-MED COURSE



UJK strongly recommends to all the accepted candidates enrolling the online Anatomy Pre-Med course. The course has been specially designed for international students studying medicine in Poland. It is fully adapted to Polish med schools' requirements.

The course supports students in acquiring extensive knowledge by improving memory capacities of anatomy terminology and scientific aspects.

The online course was designed by the scientific staff of Jan Kochanowski University and aims at increasing the passing rate of the Anatomy course.

Recruitment for MD Program in English at the Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce (UJK) is conducted by <u>Owl-Med. Healthcare education</u>. Owl-Med. Healthcare education is the official partner of the UJK in the recruitment process for MD Program in English

Owl-Med provides authorized admission aid to Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce and supplies a number of additional post-admission services, such as:

Airport reception

• Recognition of diplomas Assistance in the process of education documents recognition conducted by a province education superintendent in Poland

Legalization of stay

Assistance in the legalization of stay in Poland (help in collecting all the required documents and representing a student before the immigration department)

Q&A ON VISA REQUIREMENTS

If you need a visa, you can get it at the Polish embassy in your country. Addresses and contact details of consulates and Embassies in your country can be found <u>here</u>.

Note: To obtain visa you have to prove that you have enough money for living in Poland - with the calculation of approximately 190\$ / month + accommodation expenses + ticket for the return trip to your home country (approximately 680 \$). Please be informed that some embassies may also require to pay for at least one semester of studies. E.g. let's say your accommodation will cost 175\$ / months, thus to obtain visa for one year you have to have:

(190\$+175\$)x12months+680\$ ≈5060\$

Please note the university only provides Admission Letter required by the embassy. The university does not help with visa procedures and other formalities connected with it. If you need assistance, we recommend you to contact our Official Recruitment Agency - Owl-Med: dima@owl-med.com
