- **4) Consent for previous meeting minutes (Single Motion Needed):** Approval of Minutes from 5/23/2019 Board Meeting, motioned by Walker, seconded by Nolle, all approved.
- **5) Public Comment:** Chris Friedel of Yuba Watershed announced planned projects as follows: clear roadsides at some BLM parcels, expand out to 200 ft each side; shaded fuel break; project work on Sportsmen's archery range and Round Mountain.

## 6) Agency/Partner Reports:

<u>Sean Griffis</u> of CAL Fire: the Unit fully staffed on 2<sup>nd</sup> week of July and an engine was added in Colfax. Lookouts are open and looking for volunteers to staff them. NEU confiscated over 16 thousand pounds of illegal fireworks already in June.

<u>Jerry Martinez</u> of BLM introduced David Brensfield from the Bakersfield office. Announced June 14<sup>th</sup> fire restrictions on BLM land requiring a variance for all projects. If needed, contact Julie Martin.

<u>Jenn Tamo</u> of NevCo OES: Reported on recent and upcoming public events. Announced the Hazard mitigation grant coming from FEMA and the upcoming Board of Supervisors vote for Ponderosa West.

## Executive/Finance Committee Meeting Minutes 143 B Springhill Dr., Grass Valley, CA 95945 Thursday, August 15, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 9:31 A.M.

## In Attendance:

No public comment.

Discussion regarding Lake Wildwood Green Waste event ensued. The committee reviewed photos taken at the end of the event, as left by board members and volunteers the last day of the green waste program at this location. Executive Director Jones conveyed updates regarding next years green waste program. The Lake Wildwood Campground site will not be used and has been omitted for future green waste funding opportunities. An alternate location is being chosen based on proximity to all Penn Valley residents. Additionally, an alternate location is needed to avoid potential access and use issues that occurred at the LWW Campground site. There is still a meeting to be had regarding issues from both parties of the contract; 1. LWW states the site was to be returned to the condition it was prior to start. 2. There was existing green waste from a program the year prior, that was organized by LWW at this location. 3. The location was inaccessible the final dates of the event. 4. Residents and LWW association continued to use as a dump site outside the staffed dates and times agreed upon in contract. The Chairman, Vice-Chair, and Executive Director will all be in attendance as representation for the meeting to be scheduled for the following week.

Vice-Chair Nolle provided a working document that had been started about 4 years prior. The Executive Committee would like to revisit and update the "Objectives and Priorities" document to be adopted later. Director Weston states that the priority order and some items may need to be changed as the Executive Director role has changed immensely since the document was first proposed. Additionally, it was recommended that the order of priorities should be at the discretion of the ED and may constantly need to be adapted as partnerships and opportunities are a moving target. The Executive Committee will bring a new draft for review and potential formal adoption.

ED Jones reports that Ponderosa is live. Flagging has started and the Washington Ridge Crews will likely begin in the coming weeks once sensitivity training has been completed. The vehicles and equipment needed for project implementation will be finalized in the coming weeks.

ED Jones states the at the new Project manager, Matthew Frink has been a phenomenal addition to the team and has been instrumental in the success of the Ponderosa Project launch. Christopher Wackerly has started to transition to the Field Operations Manager position. He will spend few weeks bringing online the new Jobber software and integration to be used for the chipping program and for

projects. Additionally, both Chris and Matt will be completing training to fully execute their positions as they pertain to the Ponderosa Project.

ED Jones reports that they have found a location to store the equipment that is currently still at the 139 E Main Street office. The new location at 1442 E Main Street will be used to store existing equipment and the new equipment arriving for the Ponderosa Project. The lease for the building is still pending a couple of items to be approved by the City of Grass Valley. The Treasurer states that the building is within the current budget and he recommends we proceed. The ED will finalize details and lease in the coming weeks. This also allows the City of Grass Valley to potentially utilize The Eagle Hose Firehouse as recently discussed. The ED states that the SNAP program will be added to the agenda for the next board meeting to be renamed for consistent titling and clarification with our County, Sate and Federal Partners. The board will also present and approve the new recommendations for Director and Secretary.

The Red Zone Affair was discussed and will be added to the agenda for promotion and discussion.

Closed session began at 10:37 AM

Report out of closed session: Drummond vs. FSCNC will facilitate a closed session at the August 22nd, 2019 board meeting. Directors and legally named participants should be in attendance.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:58 A.M.

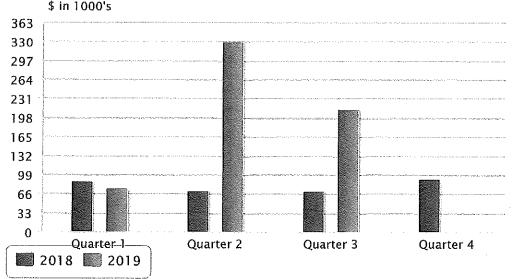

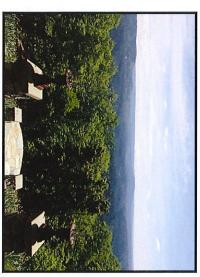
