 - a. Operations update: Attracting and maintaining employees is becoming more difficult. Changes in the job markets are requiring changes in pay scales to attract and maintain employees. EDJ presented a draft of new pay scales to the Committee for review and approval.
 - b. Staffing: A new Chipping Supervisor has been hired Jeff Benen, a chipping supervisor from Santa Clara will be assuming responsibility for the DSAV program.
 - c. FEMA grant has been given its final approval. We will be applying the current award to 45 of the AFL houses that have been waiting so long. We will have to pay "prevailing wages" for these FEMA monies.
 - d. DSAV requests are quite heavy.
 - e. The Ponderosa project only has 100 acres to go to completion.
 - f. Significant State funding will be available for Greenwaste management and many applications are being developed to access these funds.
