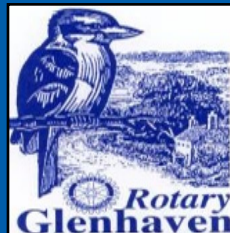

## **Board Meeting Summary - October 2019**

1. President Jan advised that she has taken over as chair of the golf committee and a meeting will be held very shortly.
2. Membership continues to be a concern.
3. Fighting for Farmers- Bendigo Bank is receiving donations for the drought relief, and it was suggested that the monies we are receiving in our bucket at the BBQ's be put into this account.
4. Resignation from Bill Smith accepted, and a motion carried to award him Honorary membership as a thank you for all the dedication he has shown to be club in the last 25 years.
5. Meeting attendance has improved, but attendance at social nights has been poor
6. Vocational Visit to Warrah on 12th November
7. Christmas carols at Warrah on 5th Dec, Glenhaven Carols by 6th December
9. 3 students from St. Bernadettes who represented their school in the Voice of Youth will present their speeches.
10. Two boys from Oakhill College will be attending the Conoco Philips Science Forum next year and we have two excellent candidates for RYPEN & RYLA
11. Claire Willacy attended the board meeting and spoke about a Run or Walk program she is involved with which is something that our club could get involved with.
