

A14 Junctions 11 to 13 electrical renewal works

Dear Customer,

Welcome to the first bulletin for the A14 junctions 11, 12 and 13 electrical renewal scheme. This scheme covers the section of the A14 from junction 11 at Cranford through to junction 13 at Thrapston.

Keeping you informed

I will be providing updates fortnightly (or as workload requires) on work completed so far and a look ahead to detail our planned works and any road closure and diversion route information. Please do get in touch directly should you have any questions.

What have we been doing?

Since the scheme commenced on 31st July we have been working on the eastbound and westbound carriageway of the A14 at junctions 11 and 12. Our works are progressing as per our planned programme.

- ✓ We have mobilised and created the site compound.
- ✓ We have cleared away any necessary vegetation to facilitate the works. This is the full length of each slip road on one side where columns will be installed and both sides at the tops to install signs.
- ✓ GPR surveys have been carried out on each of the 4 slip roads at J11 and 12 so far to confirm the network is as per the service plans and to mark out all the infrastructure on the ground prior to works commencement on each slip.
- ✓ We have installed new cable ducts across the slip roads on J11 & J12
- Surfacing and white lining has been installed on all slip roads over the cable duct road crossings except J11 EB exit.
- ✓ We have laid some of the High Friction surfacing (HFS) on J11 & J12 the remainder will be installed on the Phase 2 visit.

Looking ahead

During September we will be working on junction 13 to commence work on the entry and exit slip roads.

When will we carry out this work?


To reduce the impact on the travelling public, and for safety reasons, we will carry out this work overnight between 8pm and 6am Monday to Friday:

• The works will be carried out under a Lane 1 closure on main carriageway with a slip road closure. Ring management on the J13 gyratory.

What are the approved diversion routes?


Diversion Route A605 NB Closure Motorway Users

Traffic to continue on A14 eastbound to the A1(M)/A141 junction, take the 1st exit to join the northbound A1(M) and continue to J17, take the 1st exit to the A605 and continue. End of diversion.




Diversion Route A605 SB Closure Motorway Users

Traffic to continue along the A605, take the 4th exit onto the A1(M) southbound to the A1(M)/A141 junction, at the roundabout take the 4th exit to the A141 westbound, at the roundabout take the 1st exit to the next roundabout, take the 1st exit to the A14 westbound, join the A14 at J21, continue to A14 J13. End of diversion




Diversion Route A605 SB Closure Non-Motorway Users

Traffic to continue along the A605, for approximately 27km. Traffic to cross the A1(M) junction onto A1139 then take the exit at junction 3. Traffic to take 4th exit onto A1260 and continue to London Road RBT and take 3rd exit onto A15. Continue on A15 to A1(M) junction 16. Traffic to cross roundabout and take 2nd exit onto B1043. Traffic to take first left turn onto B1043 (B660). Traffic to cross A1(M) and take second exit at roundabout and continue on B1043. Traffic to take 3rd exit at Alconbury RBT onto B1043. Traffic to continue on B1043 then take slip road onto A1. Traffic to take first exit for A14 Kettering (W) Traffic to continue on A141 then join A14 (W). traffic to take exit at Thrapston RBT. End of diversion.



Diversion Route A605 NB Closure Non-Motorway Users

Traffic to continue along the A14 to A141 junction then take A1 North. Traffic take first exit then follow B1043. At Norman Cross RBT traffic to take 3rd exit onto A15 then take second exit at first RBT onto A1260. At second RBT traffic to take first exit onto A1139. Traffic to continue on A1139 then join A605. Traffic to continue on A605 to Thrapston. End of diversion




Diversion Route A14 J13 EB Exit Slip Closure

Traffic to continue on A14, then take slip road at J16, turn left onto B660, then left again to join A14 Westbound. Traffic to exit A14 at J13. End of diversion.




Diversion Route A14 J13 EB Entry Slip Closure

Traffic to continue on RBT and take A14 towards Kettering. Traffic to take slip road at J12, take 3rd exit at RBT onto A6116 then turn left onto A14 Eastbound. End of diversion.



Diversion Route A14 J13 WB Exit Slip Closure

Traffic to continue on A14, then take slip road at J12, take 3rd exit at RBT onto A6116 then turn left onto A14 Eastbound. Traffic to exit A14 at J13. End of diversion.




Diversion Route WB Entry Slip Closure

Traffic to take A14 Eastbound, then take slip road at J16, turn left onto B660, then left again to join A14 Westbound. Traffic to exit A14 at J13. End of diversion.



Diversion Route A45 NB Closure

Traffic to continue South along the A45, at the A6 roundabout take the 4th exist on the A6, continue on the A6 until A6/A14 RBT take the 3rd exit onto A14, and continue to the A14 J13 roundabout. End of diversion.



What about noise and lighting?

We will keep noise levels as low as possible and will prioritise the noisiest works between 8pm to midnight.
