ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6 OF
ORDINANCE NO. 630 OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 630, of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Pemberville, relating to the Village Income Tax, and collection of same, is hereby amended by adding Section (d) as follows:

(d) Within 30 days after a new tenant occupies rental property of any kind within the Village, the owner of such rental property shall file with the Tax Commissioner of the Village a report showing the names, addresses, telephone numbers, if available, and place of employment, if available, of each such tenant who occupies the property. Within 30 days after a tenant vacates rental property of any kind within the Village, the owner of such property shall file with the Tax Commissioner a report of the date of such vacation and identity of the vacating tenant.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the effective collection of income tax due the Village is necessary to preserve the effective operation of the Village, and thereby protect the public health, safety and well being of the Village of Pemberville and its citizens.
