**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 630 PASSED
SEPTEMBER 21, 1976, AT SECTION 14 THEREOF
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That effective for the tax year 2006 and thereafter, Section 14
of Ordinance Number 630 passed September 21, 1976, is hereby amended and
adopted in full as follows:

Section 14. The credit for tax paid to another municipality.

No credit for income tax payable to another municipality
shall be permitted as an offset to municipal income tax
due the Village of Pemberville.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure.
The reason for the emergency is that the prompt effectiveness of this measure is
necessary in order to maintain Village finances at an appropriate level and thereby
protect the public health, safety and well being of our citizens.
Ordinance Number 1243 is hereby repealed.
