

## Streets, Lands & Buildings (SL&B) – March 14, 2023

- 1) Oberhouse Park – Letter was mailed to the Oberhouse's on 2/22/2023. Mayor will send a follow up in 30 days if they haven't contacted the Village.
- 2) Cold Patch – Jeff & Matt to fill the pot holes and identified several streets that need patched/sections replaced, etc. Jeff to get with Nathan and Landry to coordinate some repairs with work they are doing.
- 3) Welcome to Pemberville Signs – Bob Bruning placed a temporary solar light on the east sign to give an idea of what the signs will look like. Jeff Barres to
- 4) Replacement signs – Many still need replaced. Jeff indicated he just got some new ones in.
- 5) Walking Bridge by Carryout – Bridge has been completed. Rahe will take pictures for the grant and council.
- 6) Tree Commission – Mayor provided a check list she would like the commission to start using.
- 7) Leaf Machine – Leaf Machine has been fixed and ready for pick up at Troy Township.
- 8) Municipal Building:
  - (a) Fence – Jeff & Matt to paint/stain the fence around the municipal buildings. Bob Burning offered his paint sprayer. Marcia to contact Sherwin Williams for a recommendation on type of stain to use.
  - (b) Tom Oberhouse would like to plant trees on Village property by the recycling bins. Rahe will advise Tom to coordinate with Jeff & Matt. Only concern is mowing.
- 9) Parks & Recreation:
  - (a) Splash Pad – Plans to complete when the weather breaks
  - (b) Back Boards for basketball court need hung
  - (c) Park Shelter House – Possibly remove door/windows for the summer. No decision made.
  - (d) Park Spot Light is staying on 24 hours. Jeff Barres may need to change the sensor so light goes off during the day
- 10) Town Hall:
  - (a) Woman's toilet in downstairs bathroom needs fixed
  - (b) Painting of Council Chambers – Committee agreed Jeff & Matt should be able to paint. Further discussion at next meeting.
- 11) Fair Board – Mayor & Rahe to attend Fair board meeting to discuss usage of the Shelter House (why they remove the doors), bleachers stored at Municipal Building, plans for items stored in grey building at Memorial park, and maintenance of Village property after the fair.
- 12) Sidewalk Replacement Ordinance – Mayor presented an update to the ordinance for the Village to replace sidewalks damaged by Village trees. Committee agrees with the updates and will present to council.
- 13) Kesson Road – Tom Oberhouse contacted Rahe about repairing Kesson Road. Further evaluation needs to be made.
- 14) Sand Stone – The Village has a lot of sand stone to get rid of. Further discussion on how to get rid of.
