Issues:

- 1. Insurance for Bourdo's
  - a. Marsha Bourdo is not taking Village insurance.
  - b. Jeff's increased because of his 65th birthday.
    - i. \$1469.04 to \$1941.91 per month. The Village shares 85%.
    - ii. That was taken into account during the 2023 permanent appropriations.
- 2. How we count Employees
  - a. In 2017, there was 8 full time, 12 part-time, and 12 seasonal employees. In 2023, there are 15 full time, 5 part-time, and 15 seasonal employees.
  - b. These numbers do not include elected officials.
  - c. The Village is over 20 employees.
- 3. Time Clocks
  - a. The question concerning constant tracking was answered. The system only tracks when the employee clocks in and out.
  - b. APP for the phone is free. The tap unit cost \$248.
  - c. This was tabled
- 4. Temporary Appropriations
  - a. Ms. Dyer shared the begin docs. used to start temporary appropriations.
- 5. Comp Time
  - a. Councilman Angel is going to reach out to the employees about these changes.
  - b. The policy suggested to the Council will be capping at 40 hours and paid out at the end of the year.
- 6. Councilwoman Sue Rahe's email
  - a. Councilman Angel shared his concerns about an email Councilwoman Rahe sent to Mayor Bailey accusing her of withholding information from the Council.
  - b. Councilman Angel felt that it was also an accusation against himself and the Personnel Committee.
  - c. The Committee agreed unanimously to take this issue to the Council.
- 7. Credit Card Policy
  - a. The state Auditor's office was contacted and asked to review the policy.
  - b. The Auditors office has no issue with the proposed policy.
- 8. Bridge
  - a. Ord. 1646 will be on the table tonight for the design cost of the Bridge Street bridge. The money will come from permanent improvements. \$242,000 will be the bill for that portion of the project.

## 9. Property of Water Street

- a. There is a question concerning the ownership of a Township building on Water Street.
- b. The Council and the Township will need to determine who is the proper owner.
- c. The Township would like to sell the property if they own it.
