Third Reading – Ordinance 2020-30: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 618.01 ENTITLED “DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE, DANGEROUS AND VICIOUS DOGS” OF CHAPTER 618 ENTITLED “ANIMALS” OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF VERMILION, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
