<u>Call to Order:</u> Greg Drew, Chairman, RESOLVED THAT this Legislative Committee comprised of the committee of the whole does now come to order.

TOPIC ONE: Review of Ordinance 2022-2 (Parking Near Mailboxes)

G. Drew asked Chief Hartung his thoughts of modifying the ordinance to include a time period. He said they are not trying to stop people from parking in front of a mailbox at 10 p.m., so he suggested they insert 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the ordinance to prevent neighbor disputes and having the police being called at 7:00 p.m., and expecting the officers to come out and cite vehicles that are parked in front of the mailboxes at 7:00 p.m. Chief Hartung said it really is not an issue that comes up a lot. When it did come up, they did not have a mechanism to address it, so everything council provides is a tool. They do not issue citations to raise revenues, but the purpose is to correct a behavior. He said the circumstance that brought this to their attention hasn't had a call since November. They did call a few weeks ago, but it was due to blocking the snowplow from doing its job.

S. Herron said he reflected on this matter for a week and concluded that G. Drew was right as they do not need to over legislate their streets.

<u>G. Drew MOVED</u>; M. Stark seconded to amend Ordinance 2022-2 to insert the hours between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Roll Call Vote 7 YEAS. <u>MOTION CARRIED</u>.
