

## Speedwatch Report for 26 June 2023 RSPC Meeting

- For a variety of reasons, we have not carried out any sessions since the last meeting. This is because of a lack of availability of volunteers due to family commitments, work commitments, holidays and (in one case), injury due to a cycling accident – now thankfully recovering.
- However, we plan to get back on track starting with a morning session this coming Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June.
- We have still not been able to integrate our latest volunteer into the team as he has yet to receive his “Roadside Safety Briefing”. This is due to the absence from work of our allocated PCSO. I have passed on the best wishes of the CSW team and the PC to the individual concerned.
- It is of concern that there seems not to be any contingency plans to cover unforeseen absences in the local Police Safer Neighbourhoods Team (SNT) who provide a range of policing, not just CSW support. The published SNT telephone number was unanswered over a period of days and messages requesting callback were ignored. A “robust” email did elicit a prompt response but this was not followed up by any action or further communication. This has now been escalated to Warwickshire Police and a response is awaited.
