Introductory Dressage High Point Award: highest single score in class 4 (tiebreaker highest collectives)

Training Level Dressage High Point Award: highest single score in class 5 or 6 (tiebreaker highest collectives)

First Level Dressage High Point Award: highest single score in class 7 (tiebreaker highest collectives)

Second/Third Level Dressage High Point Award: highest single score in class 8 (tiebreaker highest level difficulty test)

Western Pleasure High Point Thoroughbred: high point based on classes 35-39 (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

Thoroughbred Cross Rails Division: daily high point based classes 14-16 and 40-42 (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

Very Green Hunter Division (2'0"): daily high point based on classes 17-19 and 43-45 (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

Special Hunter Division (2'6"): daily high point based on classes 20-22 and 46-48 (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

Low Thoroughbred Hunter Division (3'0"): daily high point based on classes 23-25 and 49-51 (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

Hunter Classic Medal: medal awarded to highest placing TIP eligible horse in class 53

Jumper 0.6 meter division: daily high point based on classes 27-28 and 54-55 (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

Thoroughbred Hopeful Jumper I: daily high point based on classes 29-30 and 56-57 (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

Thoroughbred Schooling Jumper III: daily high point based on classes 31-32 and 58-59 (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

Jumper Classic Medal: medal awarded to highest placing TIP eligible horse in class 58

Junior Rider High Point Award (all divisions/disciplines): daily high point based on all classes (tiebreaker most blue ribbons)

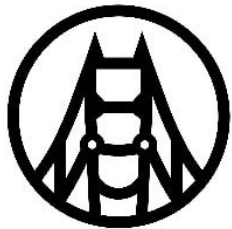
General Rules

- All classes are open to Thoroughbreds registered with the Jockey Club or relevant foreign stud book, and Standardbreds registered with the United States Trotting Association. At the show management's discretion, a horse's identity will be verified by reading lip tattoos or database look up, and if such identity cannot be reasonably established, such horse may be immediately disqualified with any placings and prizes revoked and entrant forfeits refund of any show fees.
- Half-thoroughbreds (one registered thoroughbred parent) or unregistered thoroughbreds, as determined at the entrant's reasonable discretion may also compete, but are not eligible for any prize money.
- TIP number must be provided before the show start date to be eligible for TIP division honors and special classes. **NOTE: TIP numbers are unique to horse & rider combination. If your horse was previously registered with a different rider, you will need a new TIP number.**
- Entries for dressage will close on Sunday, April 24 (late entries allowed if schedule permits) and ride times will be published on Wednesday, April 27. No refunds for class fees once entries close unless your spot is filled.
- Schooling: Warm-up arenas will be available from noon on Friday through the end of the show on Sunday. The show arenas will be open for schooling on Friday from 12-5pm with registration, \$20 per horse. On Saturday and Sunday, the show arenas may be used for hacking only NO JUMPING, outside of show hours.
- USEF rules* apply, except riders may wear schooling attire – please contact show management in advance of the show start date if you need any accommodations (non-standard equipment, etc.) to make this a positive experience for you or your horse.
- Optimum Time Jumper Classes: 300 mpm for 0.6m classes, 325 mpm for 0.75 and 0.9m classes
- Freestyle: The Freestyle performance should be approx. 5 minutes in length; entrants will have a total of 10 minutes in the arena for any set up or take down which each entrant is responsible for. Costumes and props must be safe for horse and rider, and may not include fire or firearms. Judging criteria based on trainability/horse's demeanor, degree of difficulty, and creativity.
- All classes will be judged as one open division unless size warrants splitting. Ribbons through 6th place. Division highpoints will be calculated as follows: 1st 7; 2nd 5; 3rd 3; 4th 1 (tiebreaker optimum speed class for 0.6m jumpers, points over fences for hunters)
- Prize money will be split as follows: 1st 30%; 2nd 22%; 3rd 15%; 4th 14%; 5th 12%; 6th 7%. If there are less than 6 entrants, the same breakdown applies and any remaining sums will go to show expenses. Prize money will be applied against your show bill, or mailed by check within 30 days of the end of the competition. NTE will not issue any tax forms for prize money distributed unless the total amount to any individual exceeds \$600.
- All riders must complete an entry form and sign a release form.
- By taking part in this event, you consent to being photographed or filmed, and grant the event organizers full rights to use any images or video clips for fundraising, publicity or other purposes to help achieve the group's aims. This might include (but is not limited to), the right to use them in their printed and online publicity and social media.
- Health regulations will be posted based on the then-existing conditions and requirements. Please do not attend if you have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19.
