### New Evacuation Info— Know Your Zone!

In the event of a wildfire or an emergency situation, law enforcement and fire agencies will issue evacuation warnings or orders for impacted areas. Authorities will use Zone Names in emergency alerts, media releases, and on social media to notify residents which areas are under an evacuation warning or order.

All DeerCreek SouthSide neighborhoods are within zone: **Nev-E252** 

### Message from your Fire Chiefs of Nevada County:

*In case of a wildfire*— *Evacuate Early!* Be prepared and be aware of all possible routes before an emergency hits. Grab your packed Go Bag, family members and pets and leave! Go to a spot maybe down the hill you've picked out ahead of time (coffee shop, mall, friend's house etc.) and meet up with other family members, friends or neighbors. *And if you hear the Hi-Lo Siren it means Leave Now!*



#### Briefly, being a Firewise USA® Community involves:

- -Forming a committee to maintain the program and tracking its progress or status.
- -Observe a Firewise Communities USA® Day each year that is dedicated to a local Firewise project.
- This can take the form of a potluck with a speaker and literature, a workday for clearing roadsides, or other events.
- --Invest a minimum of \$2.00 per capita annually in Firewise projects in your neighborhood. This is NOT a cash investment -hours worked by volunteers on clearing roadsides, creating defensible space, etc. have a dollar value -- currently about \$29/hour -- you can track and count toward the requirement.
- -Report annually online to Firewise USA<sup>®</sup> to document continuing compliance with the program. It's an easy process to fill in the blanks regarding your neighborhood activities, hours spent, etc.
