What is the biblical definition of Restore? In the Bible, restoration is always in abundance. When something is restored, it is always better than it was to begin with. God's promise to us is a better way, a better life, a better future for ourselves and our loved ones. ... Yet even though all these things happened to Job, he did not turn from his God.

Establish

ESTABLISH

What does God will establish you mean? God is able to establish you—to get you to the place spiritually where your walk with Him cannot be shaken, where the testing of your faith will only make it stronger-to place you securely and permanently in a position of faith, a situation of blessing, and a condition of peace.

Christians in general, especially within the Evangelical tradition, use the term "to testify" or "to give one's testimony" to mean "to tell the story of how one became a Christian". Commonly it may refer to a specific event in a Christian's life in which God did something deemed particularly worth sharing. to make a formal statement of what is true, especially in a court of law
