The Council of International Fellowship Israel is a non-profit, politically and religiously independent organization which organizes in Israel the

***17th International Professional Exchange Program (IPEP)  
and the 2nd Peace Project from October 3, 2021 to October 17, 2021***

The program combines theoretical and practical training. The main goals are to promote peace and understanding, cultural-professional exchange and mutual learning among the participants and the hosting country.

The Peace project goals are to provide tools to learn to open up, understand and respect other cultures, to expose the participants along with Israeli Jewish and Arabic professionals (Muslims, Christians, Bedouins) the everyday life together.

The program is planned for 4 professionals in the social and educational fields who are interested to learn about methods for reconciliation, developing resilience and additional components that are used to solve conflicts in order to enable 2 nations to coexist in spite of different cultures, religions and beliefs.

The Program includes orientation to the Israeli cultural-social-political structure as well as to the unique professional issues encountered by professionals in relation to the Jewish-Arab conflict.

Participants will visit social and educational institutions and agencies which deal with Arab and Jewish populations. The program will take place in a village Wahat al-Salam (Neve Shalom - Oasis of Peace), Jerusalem, Tel-Aviv, the Galilee (north) and the Negev (south). The participants should have a good English in order to engage in discussions with Israeli and Arab professionals.

During the program participants will stay with host families (Arab and Jewish) to get acquainted with the Israeli way of life.

Participants will pay 350 Euro (or equivalent in US Dollars) as a fee for the program and will be responsible for their personal luggage and health insurance as well as for overseas travel expenses.

Deadline for applications is March 31st 2021 through the national branch.
