The following is a summary of the main areas in which you can help keep WFS members, guests and HBCC staff, safe. By carefully following this advice, our screenings should remain an enjoyable get together with a very low risk.

- If you have even the mildest symptoms, please stay at home & get tested.
- Pre-book: contact Michael Slee and provide names (first & last) and contact phone numbers, of all people attending the film screening with you. This will help with contact tracing should it be necessary.

- Arrive at the venue on time. Try not to be too early (or late) and leave promptly following the film.
- No mask – No Movie: please wear a fitted mask the entire time you are in council buildings.
- You are allowed to sit in ‘household’ groups.
- BYO refreshments (sorry, no sharing outside household groups).
- Maintain social distancing at all times – 1.5m (let’s keep the hugs, kisses & handshakes on the screen).
- Sanitise/wash hands regularly.
- Our screenings are seated events (sorry, no roaming or standing around and chatting).
