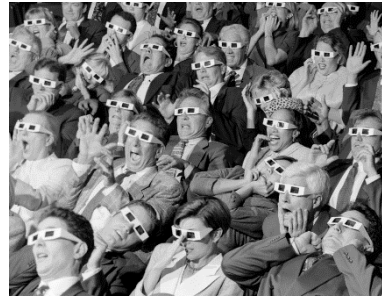

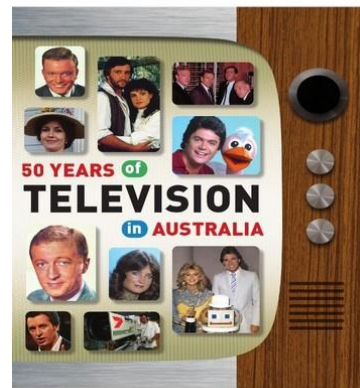

The film 'Loving Vincent' & the artist was Vincent Van Gogh.



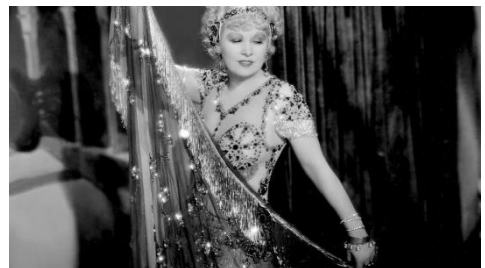

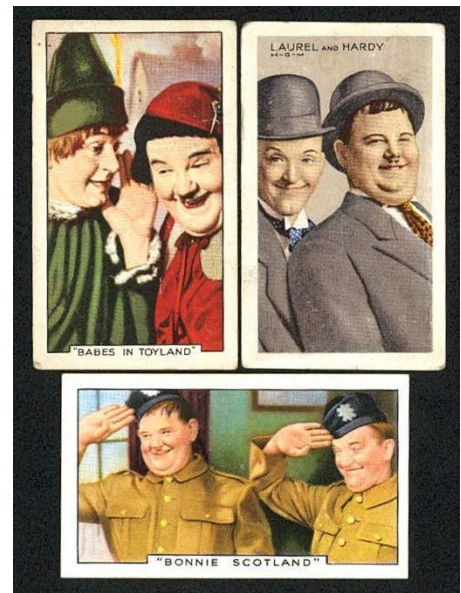

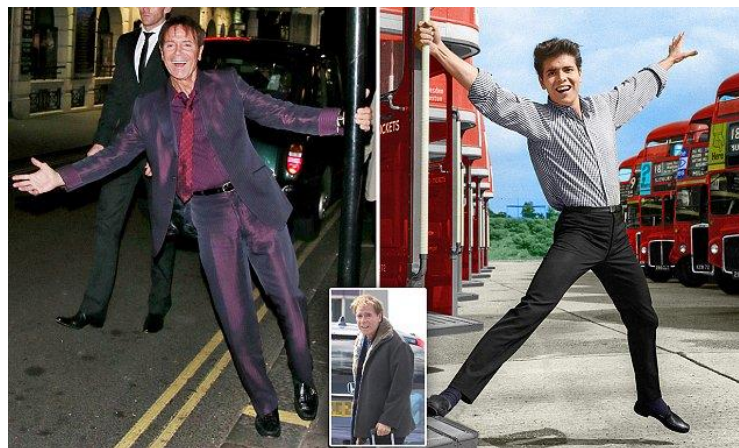

Q32 Marge Champion was the model the Disney Animators referred to when drawing Snow White (they were all men). The picture shows Snow, young Marge and a more mature Marge.

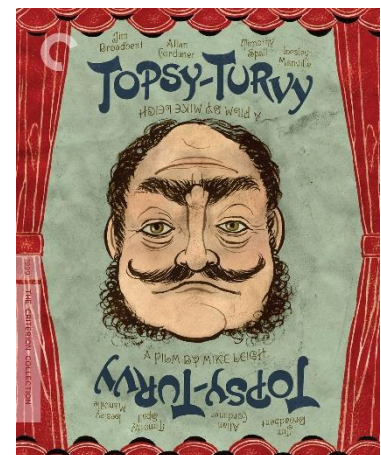

Q33 The extremely young, sleeping Sean Connery was taking a break on the set of 'Dr No'.

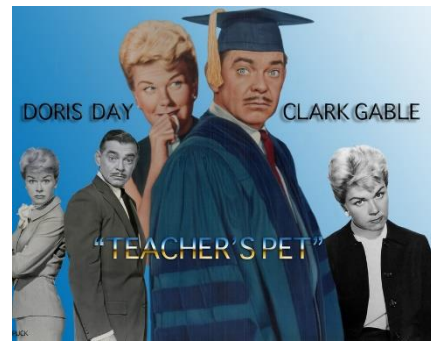


Q34 W.S. Gilbert was born on the 18th of November.

Q41 Rosalie Blum won the Cesar award for Best First Film in 2017.

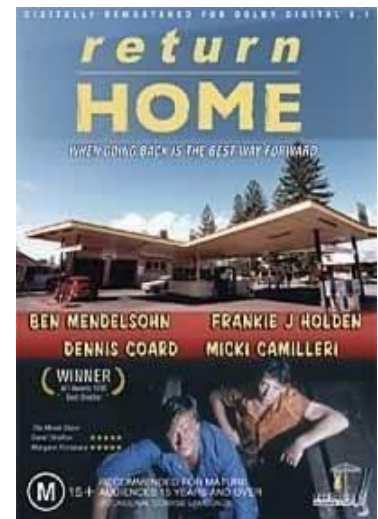
Q42 Vincent, the male lead character in *Rosalie Blum*, is a hairdresser.
