# **Treasurer Report September 2021**

Three significant items of expenditure over the summer:

- Cherry Orchard water bill £63
- New mower for Netherstowe £210
- 2nd installment of LCC rent £550

Summary of our current position:

#### **Secretary Report September 2021**

There has been no response regarding the upcoming vacancy for the secretary position. Following on from Shenstone & Stonnall Allotments' request for help with their vacant plots, I have passed on five names from interested people on our waiting list. I have kept them on our waiting list too so that they will not miss out if they are not required by Shenstone. Gordon Phillips has now received his trophies for heaviest potato crop and heaviest potato competitions.

I have met with Bernard Derrick regarding the parking problems at Christchurch. On busy match days the car park becomes full (blocking our entry to and exit from the site) and the overspill football supporters park illegally on the verge on the A51, causing a very dangerous exit from the car park by obstructing the view of the road. He is in discussion with the two councils involved and will keep us updated.

There have been 12 new waiting list additions, and numbers are now 105.

## **Site Report The Moggs September 2021**

Plots 19a and 36b have been let out. This will leave 1b, 10 and 31a vacant for the new season. Each have been covered and let fallow until the March to help in clearing weeds. 10 will probably be split into 2.

#### **Site Report Netherstowe September 2021**

The work has at last been completed by Severn Trent so the water leak, fingers crossed, is now fixed. I put in a claim for compensation but as the land is not ours any compensation would have to go to our landlord being the council which does make sense.

The good news is I have managed to get ST to agree to re surface the car park with 20 tons of MOT 1 hardcore and also throw a skip in for us to use as we have so rubbish to move so a free skip always very welcome. The work is going ahead on the 20 & 21st of this month. They are using a professional contractor which I have insisted on!

The car park / turning circle at Netherstowe is in desperate need of attention and would have cost the society heavily next year so I hope you all agree this was the best trade off we could really go for.

### **Site Report Beacon Street September 2021**

Plots 3A1 &2 are now ready for new tenants. Can I have two names from the Waiting List please?

Another plot will be vacated at the end of this month and will need tidying before being re-let. An oak tree in the hedge along Forge Lane needs some low branches removed before the top of the hedge can be cut. Does the Society own a long-handled pruning saw? The area of rough grass at the top of the allotments has been strimmed.
