Persistent complaints about cycling on the public footpath between Newton Street and Mill Street have continued and residents are reminded that it is **ILLEGAL** to cycle along this route which is for pedestrians only. It is also an offence not to clear up dog-fouling.

The first invoices on the new electricity supply contract for the street lighting have been received and show that with the conversion to LED lanterns the cost is now 43% of the previous rate and will save around £2,500/year. Long term maintenance costs will also be reduced.

In addition to the Community Infrastructure Levy received in respect of the Manor Road development (mentioned in the past edition) Broadland District Council have confirmed that they have received substantial funds under section 106 of the planning permission which can be called upon by the Parish Council for future infrastructure projects over the next ten years.

Overhanging hedges continue to be a problem at this time of the year and residents are asked to take appropriate action to avoid inconvenience to passing pedestrians.

The Council have received a detailed report by a civil engineering consultant on the work carried out on the drive and park at Blind Lane cemetery and are taking advice on how to proceed in this matter.

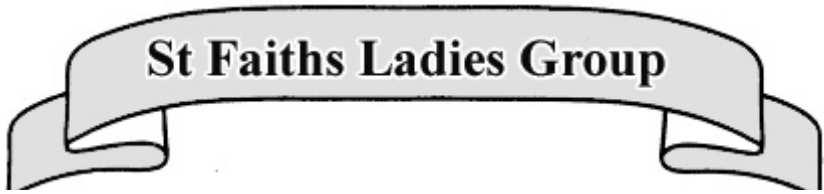

# STRAWBERRIES

## How to keep them fresh:



The trick is to keep berries cold and dry so they won't mold.

For the short term - arrange the berries (without washing or removing the stems) on a paper towel-lined tray and cover with plastic wrap; then refrigerate.

Before eating or using them, wash the berries under cool water and then remove stems.

## Farmers Reveal Trick On How To Keep Strawberries Fresh For Weeks:

1. Make a solution out of vinegar and water (3 cups water to 1 cup white vinegar). ...
2. After they're completely dry, place them back in a container lined with paper towels.
3. Place the strawberries upright in rows.
4. Store in a refrigerator until you use them.
