

Christmas and Epiphany have now reached their conclusion with the Feast of Candlemas (Feb.2nd) rounding it all off. Candlemas is when we celebrate Jesus being presented in the Temple. It was the moment when Mary and Joseph dedicated their Son to God's service, at the same time agreeing to bring him up in God's ways. On entering the Temple, the baby was instantly recognised as the promised Messiah that had been long awaited. Both Simeon and Anna spent most of their time praying in the Temple, and had looked forward, with eager anticipation, to the coming of this Messiah. Simeon had been promised by God that he would indeed see the Messiah before he died, and he was already a very old man. Both Simeon and Anna were very close to God and spoke with him regularly which was why, when Jesus arrived with his parents, (although there were no fanfares or parades) this special baby was, at once, familiar to them. They saw his face and they saw Emmanuel – God-with-us.

As I mentioned, the seasons of Christmas and Epiphany are now behind us; the trees and the cribs have been removed from our homes and churches, and very shortly we will be entering into the season of Lent. The cemetery drive issue still remains un-resolved. The installing contractor has marginally improved their proposals for remedial action but the Council did not feel that this met their requirements. The Council is now in discussion with their legal advisors which may involve future formal court proceedings.

At the December meeting the Council set the parish precept (the Parish share of the Council Tax) and they have made an increase of 4.7%. In reality this is no increase as the number of properties coming on stream in the Manor Road development which will contribute to the total means that individual households will pay approximately the same as last year.

Although Covid restrictions are being relaxed the Council has decided that the February, March and April meetings will be held in the Mission Room to allow more space for members and residents.



Elm Class - Ella-Bea for being creative with learning through play


Chestnut Class - Elsie for a beautiful original song and dance in our Children in Need talent show
