With rising costs we, like many others, are struggling and need to know what we can do to encourage more use of the many excellent facilities that are available on your doorstep.

We hope to arrange an Open Day to show off the Centre and those who use it for classes such as Archery, Short Mat Bowls, Petanque. Table Tennis, Childrens' Dance Classes and Karate.

Hire is also available for Weddings, Parties, Childrens' Parties and business Training Purposes.

## FUTURE PROJECTS

We currently are looking into re-siting the childrens play area as the old one is now in a sad state (it is 42 years old after all) and possibly moving it into the Tennis Court area which is never used now and would be a very safe area for the children. we are applying for grants and possible help from the Parish Council. The need for this has been accelerated by some thoughtless person who thought it was a good idea to set fire to the fence around the play area. (See Page 5)

We also intend to thin the woods under the guidance of the Forestry Commission and plant new growth to stimulate and brighten up the woods. The cost of this would be offset by the sale of the timber recovered from felling.

There is also a constantly lengthening list of repairs needing doing as the Centre is now over 40 years old and is beginning to look its age. We have more than our fair share of leaking pipes and worn out fittings which we are slowly managing to get sorted so please be patient if you find you have to use another area. We are trying to get it done with the least upheaval but its not easy.

The pandemic has not helped as we have had two years with very little income and as with everyone we are suffering enormous energy bills. We have had to make increases in prices but have kept them to a minimum and still offer excellent value for money.

Although we have a full Committee compliment at present, we do need some new blood with new ideas and you can be part of this by organising events and activities that interest you and by generally helping out with the day to day problems

Thank you to everyone who came along to support our Parish Fair last month. It was lovely to see so many of you. Thankfully the weather was kind to us, and a good time was had by all! Special thanks go to the Scout Association who erected the marquees beforehand and some of the gazebos on the day; and to all who delivered the raffle ticket books along with the Parish News and St Faiths Journal. Thanks too to everyone who contributed in any way and who helped on the day. We couldn't have done it without you! More details elsewhere in this issue.

I don't know about you, but to me the summer – along with the rest of the year – seems to be flying by. Someone said the other day that Christmas was getting closer -but I'd rather not think about that right now, and I'm sure I'm not alone. We do, however, need to think about harvest, surrounded as we are by God's wonderful creation. It is good to see the crops growing well and the tractors on our roads heralding the onset of harvest. Once again this year we have heard of so many tragedies and seen so many horrific images; in particular floods, wildfires, earthquakes and of course the war in Ukraine. It is hard for us to imagine sometimes, the devastation that has been caused. Whole communities have been destroyed: lives, homes and businesses all lost, and with that, all the crops and grains that would have fed those people throughout the coming year. It certainly makes us count our blessings here – however much we complain about our English weather. The whole point of Harvest Festivals is to take the first and very best fruits of our labour and offer it back to God and to give thanks for all the blessings we receive from God.

Many of us now don't produce our own crops but rather rely heavily on our farmers and farm workers to do it for us. Our task, therefore, is to give of what we do have back to God so that it can be used to help those who most need it: be it the local food bank, a homeless shelter, or a charity, either here or overseas. In a way, it isn't too important who receives it, what is important is that we play our part in alleviating the suffering of those less fortunate than ourselves. In these days when we are all having to tighten our belts and shop more carefully, it might be more difficult to make those donations, but every little helps, as they say! As Mahatma Gandhi once said, "There is enough in our world for everyone's need -but not for everyone's greed." If we all do our bit the world would be a better, fairer place.

We will be celebrating our Parish Harvest Festival in Spixworth Church on September 25th at 10am and you will be most welcome. We look forward to seeing you.

Let's remember just how much we owe to the God who loves and cares for us, and who is so generous to us; and try to repay at least some of that love by helping those who are struggling to live.


The children have been incredible this year and I cannot wait for the coming year to see what it brings!


