We hope to arrange an Open Day to show off the Centre and those who use it for classes such as Archery, Short Mat Bowls, Petanque. Table Tennis, Childrens' Dance Classes and Karate.

Hire is also available for Weddings, Parties, Childrens' Parties and business Training Purposes.

FUTURE PROJECTS

We currently are looking into re-siting the childrens play area as the old one is now in a sad state (it is 42 years old after all) and possibly moving it into the Tennis Court area which is never used now and would be a very safe area for the children. we are applying for grants and possible help from the Parish Council. The need for this has been accelerated by some thoughtless person who thought it was a good idea to set fire to the fence around the play area. (See Page 5)

We also intend to thin the woods under the guidance of the Forestry Commission and plant new growth to stimulate and brighten up the woods. The cost of this would be offset by the sale of the timber recovered from felling.

There is also a constantly lengthening list of repairs needing doing as the Centre is now over 40 years old and is beginning to look its age. We have more than our fair share of leaking pipes and worn out fittings which we are slowly managing to get sorted so please be patient if you find you have to use another area. We are trying to get it done with the least upheaval but its not easy.

The pandemic has not helped as we have had two years with very little income and as with everyone we are suffering enormous energy bills. We have had to make increases in prices but have kept them to a minimum and still offer excellent value for money.

Although we have a full Committee compliment at present, we do need some new blood with new ideas and you can be part of this by organising events and activities that interest you and by generally helping out with the day to day problems


The children have been incredible this year and I cannot wait for the coming year to see what it brings!

This month we had an outing to the Cromer Pier Show.


The coach was full and took the members down to the Cromer Pier entrance and more importantly brought them back up again.
