Day 1 – Tuesday – Home to Bendigo

This morning we welcome everyone on-board as we begin our journey **Bendigo**. Enjoying **Morning Tea** enroute we make our way to **The Mill Market Castlemaine**. Starting as the Castlemaine Woollen Mill in 1875, and finishing as Victoria Carpets in 2013, The Mill has transformed into a place for food and artisan manufacturing, a part of Castlemaine's vibrancy. We enjoy some time here to browse the markets Vintage & Artisan precincts, with a visit to the Food precinct to purchase some lunch from one of the lovely vendors on site. Arriving in Bendigo we make our way to **The Great Stupa for a guided tour**—The Great Stupa of Universal Compassion. A stupa (also known as a pagoda) is the most sacred building in Buddhism. We will enjoy a guided tour here and learn a little more about the project. We will visit the grounds of the Peace Park and view the Jade Buddha for Universal Peace. After an interesting afternoon we head to our hotel to settle in and relax before meeting for a lovely **2 course dinner** in the hotels **Lakeside Restaurant**

Day 2 – Wednesday (B/L/D)

After a hearty cooked breakfast, we head out to explore Bendigo a little more. There is no better way to see the sights of Bendigo than aboard one of the iconic **Vintage Talking Trams**.

A Vintage Talking Tram Tour is the best way to get your bearings and see the city's key landmarks and monuments. Next, we make our way to the **Bendigo Gallery** for the **Women's Weekly – 90 Years of an Australian Icon Exhibition.** This exhibition marks the 90th anniversary of The Australian Women's Weekly through a look back at some of the inspiring women who have been part of the magazine's history, the changing eras of fashion and style brought to life on its pages, and the creativity it has inspired in the domestic sphere. This exhibition honours the contributions of some of the trailblazing women who have made the Weekly a magazine for women, by women, from its very beginnings. We are in no hurry so please do take your time. Lunch today is in the Gallery Café on View - Bagels or Toasties followed by two Sweet Treats from the Women's Weekly Cookbook – allowing you to sit and enjoy or spend some more time with the Exhibition. After a delightful day, we head back to our hotel with time to freshen up before we head out to one of the local Restaurants for lovely dinner.

Day 3 - Thursday - Bendigo to home
