The museum showcases unique exhibitions, including homemade snowshoes used by skiing pioneers and gold mining relics from the 1880s. After a delightful lunch, we'll make our way to Mountain Fresh Fish Farm for another captivating garden tour before visiting Gunnado Berries, where we'll enjoy jams made with love and have a delightful chat with Rocky. Finally, we'll return to our motel for another exquisite dinner.

DAY 4: Mount Beauty & Eurobin

After some outside time, we'll enjoy a lovely light lunch. Then we are off to **Pepos Pumpkin Seed farm**. Australia's first and only pumpkin seed growers and producers of fine artisan oils. Located in the picturesque Ovens Valley. You are welcome to explore, taste and learn about what is made from paddock to plate. Sample the growing range of locally crafted products. Tea & Coffee are available to purchase here. We'll head back to our motel with plenty of time to freshen up for dinner.
