OVERVIEW

Fifty security fixes have been released for June 2021 Patch Tuesday by Microsoft to combat a range of vulnerabilities including six zero-days under known, active exploitation in the wild. [CVE-2021-31968](#) is also acknowledged as being a zero-day, however there are no known cases of active exploitation.
