THE ADDRESS (choose one)

Dear children of God, you have come to this church so that the Lord may seal your love in the presence of the priest and this community. Christian marriage is a sacred union, which enriches natural love. It binds those who enter it to be faithful to each other forever; it creates between them a bond that endures for life and cannot be broken; it demands that they love and honour each other (and that they accept from God the children he may give them and bring them up in his love). To help them in their marriage a husband and wife receive the life-long grace of the sacrament. Is this your understanding of marriage?

Dear children of God, you have come to this church so that the Lord may seal your love in the presence of the priest and this community. Christ blesses this love. He has already consecrated you in Baptism; now, by a special sacrament, he strengthens you to fulfil the duties of your married life.

The priest then questions the bride and bridegroom.

N and N you are about to celebrate this sacrament. Have you come here of your own free will and choice and without compulsion to marry each other? **Both: We have.** Will you love and honour each other in marriage all the days of your life? **Both: We will.** Are you willing to accept with love the children God may send you and bring them up in accordance with the law of Christ and his Church? **Both: We are.**

The priest invites the couple to declare their consent.
