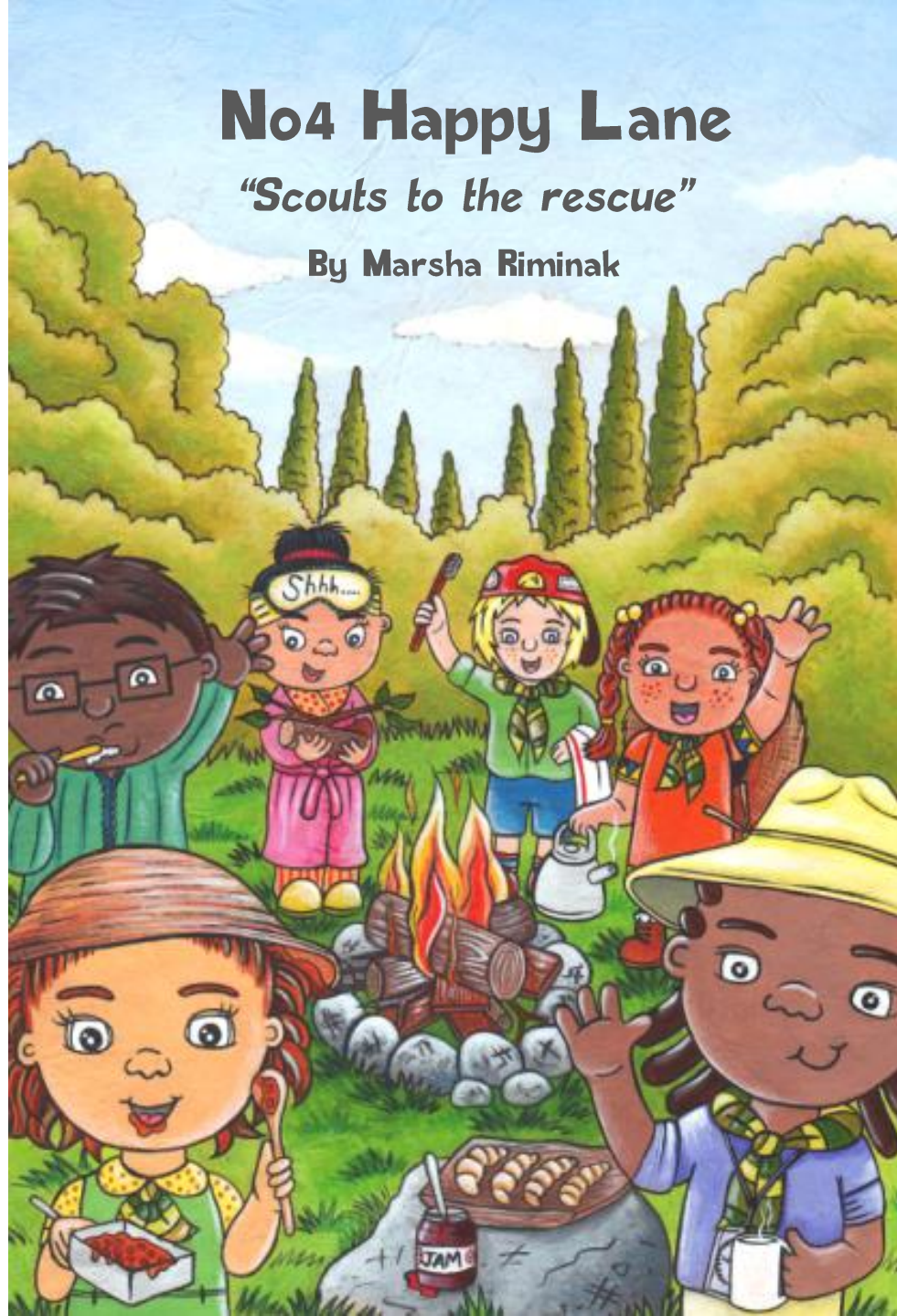

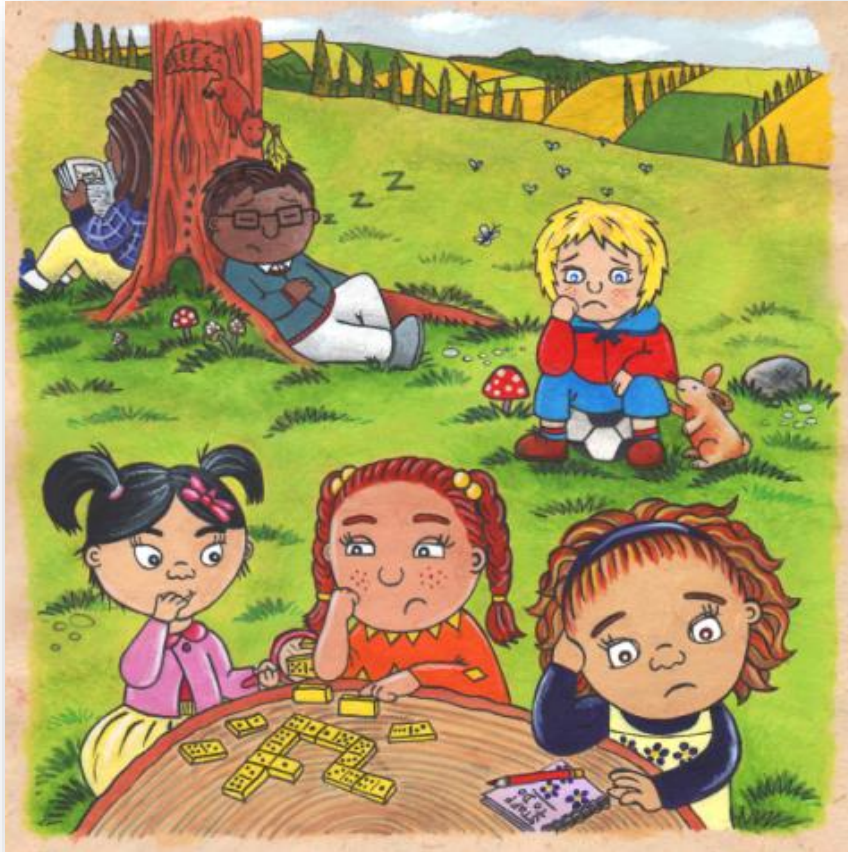


“Scouts to the rescue”
