



Controlling the Video

I have kept everything I do in the video, so you see my work from start to finish in full. I wanted to do it this way, but you should consider how you use the video

- Fast forward through steps if you think you have the idea. To help you I have indicated the position (in time) of each step of the video. For example if you have traced you might not want to watch all the drawing step.
 - Pause to look more closely at sections
 - Rewind to go back to a point in time that you want to see again
- **Stop** You may create your own work over time, even weeks, stop the video note where you are an pick up from there when you want

Key steps in the Video

Drawing starts at 4 mins 28 seconds

First watercolour wash at 39 mins and 30 seconds

Second watercolour wash starts at 59 mins 36 seconds

Third watercolour wash starts at 1 hour 37 minutes and 14 seconds

Materials List

Paper – Watercolour paper. I used Bockingford NOT 200lb (425gsm) 29X42cm
Pen – Waterproof black pen. I used Unipin with a point size of 0.3
Brushes – Size 12, 8,6,4 2 ,1. I used Sable and my smallest two sizes wer a rigger brushes

Paint - It is OK to use your normal watercolours, but I used

- Cobalt Blue
- French Ultramarine
- Prussian Blue
- Cerulean Blue
- · Permanent Magenta
- Cobalt Violet
- Burnt Umber
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umber
- Raw Sienna
- Winsor Red
- Cadmium Orange
- Lemon Yellow

Miscellaneous

- White gelyrol pen (don't worry if you haven't got one, not essential)
- White Acrylic painting
- Hogs hair brush (small) for lifting paint

Some Tips and Techniques

Drawing

- · Start inside and work outwards
- Keep the pen or pencil moving, work quickly
- · Draw what you see not what you think

Watercolour

- Step by step washes
- · Work light to dark and top to bottom
- · Mix colours on the paper whenever you can
