The Lord's Prayer is a pattern for prayer taught by Jesus. It can be split into sections. This is one method of using the prayer.

Stages of prayer - I P.R.A.Y.

1. I

Our Father which art in Heaven

Acknowledge who we are talking to. He is OUR father Acknowledge that we are HIS children and have a relationship with Him

2. P

raise Hallowed be thy name /(thine) is the power and the glory



His name is holy and He deserves our honor. Praise shows our adoration and glorifies Him.



3. \overline{R} epent & Forgive Forgive us our trespasses

as we forgive those who trespass against us

Forgiveness and repentance are necessary for our prayers to be fruitful

5. **Y**

ield Thy kingdom come, thy will be done / Thine is the kingdom

Part of asking is listening and yielding. We pray for God's Kingdom and His will to come on earth

Talking to the King

Each of the categories of the Prayer Hand follow the pattern of the Holy Spirit being planted within us as a seed and growing into a fruitful plant. Not only is this a pattern for prayer, but a pattern for our lives as well.

Isaiah 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion; to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of **praise** for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the **plant**ing of the Lord, that he might be glorified.



Rooted and grounded in (God's) love

Ephesians 3:16-19

...That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God.

- •Rooted—Can't be easily pull up.
- Grounded Receiving sustenance
- Understanding who He is (God of love) and who we are (loved by God.)
- He is our Father and we are his children.






Hallowed be thy name / (thine) is the power and the glory for ever and ever


Praise and worship soften the seed of God's spirit



Psalm 100:

• Fertilizer (spiritual nutrients): Prayer, study, church, etc. These allow God's Spirit to grow. In the parable of the sower, the seed took root in fertile soil.

• These are Miracle Grow for our spiritual plant, but God does the growing.

Isaiah 61:10

I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness

- What sin does it attacks God's plants.
- Repentance is pest control or repellent for enemy attacks.





as we forgive those who trespass against us

Forgiveness

Matthew 5:46

But I say unto you, love your enemies...That ye may be the children of your Father who is in heaven...

- Unforgiveness blocks God's forgiveness.
- Unforgiveness is like rocky soil.
- Forgiveness allows us to grow to be like Jesus.
- Forgive others and forgive self



Let go of hurts = rocks that keep the plant from having enough good soil.

T reasures (Proverbs 15:6a) In the house of the righteous is much **treasure**

Inherited Treasure!

The purpose of a plant or tree is to produce fruit.

WE do not produce fruit. They are gifts that God gives us when we have repented and forgiven others and ourselves. (John 15:5-8)

Fruit is produced to be a blessing to others. (James 5:16)

Galatians 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance; against such there is no law.

- Without fruit, we can do nothing worthwhile.
- Without love, we are clanging cymbals.
- Without fruit, we cannot be partakers and builders of the Kingdom.
- We are known by our fruit.

Ask - petitions

John 15:5-8
I am the vine, ye are the branches.
He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit; for without me ye can do nothing.

.. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

- Fruit that stays on the plant just rots.
- Fruit is for eating, sharing and giving away.
 Part of sharing God's fruit is through prayer.

Yield

3 Nephi 6:11 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you.

- We put God's will into action on the earth through prayer.
- His will on earth as it is in heaven is the goal.
- He promises that as we seek first His kingdom, he will take care of our daily needs.
- As Kingdom Kids in the Kingdom of God, let us ask, "God, what should we pray that You O Lord, will be glorified?
