Prayer Point Focus

Leader's Lesson Overview

- When we walk with the Lord, we notice other's needs. Our love for them makes us want to pray for them and ask God for his blessing for them.
- Maybe you know someone who needs prayer. Maybe a name or a picture of someone comes into your mind. That may be God asking you to pray for them.
- Supplication is asking earnestly and humbly. For children, this just means asking with their hearts instead of their heads. In other words, really meaning it and not just saying words.
- Intercession means to plead to God on someone else's behalf. Galatians 6:2 says that we are to carry each other's burdens. One way to do this is to lift others up in prayer that are in overwhelming circumstances.

Enter the Gates (opening prayers)

Pray prayers of thanksgiving and praise. What can we be thankful for today?

Let's say that to the Lord.

Prayers for the Church and Others

Pray for the pastor and the service. Pray for Gods spirit and for His words to be spoken.

Pray for protection from the enemy for the church, the leadership and yourselves.

Ask if anyone is hearing the Lord speak about needs to pray for.

Prayer Requests and Praise Reports

Don't forget to praise God for the answers that you can't see yet. Remind them to listen to His
promptings.



Lesson

First, why should we pray for others? Answers might be:

Because we love them. Because God said to. Because they need help.

Can't they pray for themselves?

Maybe they don't have the faith to pray. Maybe they don't know how or what to pray. They need support.

I Timothy 2:1

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving thanks, be made for all men;

When we care about someone, we notice their needs. If they have needs that we cannot meet, what can we do to help? We can pray!

Look at Luke 11:5-11 (You could sum this up or have someone act it out)

- 5 And he said unto them, Your heavenly Father will not fail to give unto you whatsoever ye ask of him. And he spake a parable, saying,
- 6 Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves;
- 7 For a friend of mine has come to me in his journey, and I have nothing to set before him;
- 8 And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not; the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee.
- 9 I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity, he will rise and give him as many as he needeth.
- 10 And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.
- 11 For every one who asketh, receiveth; and he that seeketh, findeth; and to him that knocketh, it shall be opened.

God is a good Father who takes care of His children. He blesses us in ways that we can't even understand.

What in the world is intercessory prayer?

What is prayer? Talking to God

What is an intercessor? Someone who prays for another person or situation. Maybe God puts someone on you mind or heart to pray for. Maybe you see a picture of them in your mind. Say a prayer for them.

Who were intercessors in the Scriptures? <u>Daniel</u>, <u>Moses</u>

Who is the greatest intercessor of all? Jesus. He is in Heaven interceding for us.

Put it into Practice

Discover how praying for others is like planting a seed of prayer and faith.

We can plant the seeds and water them with praise and faith, but God grows the fruit.

Get quiet and listen. Pray and ask God to put someone on your heart that needs prayer. Maybe you will think of a name. Maybe you will get a picture of someone in your mind. Maybe you remember a need.

Remember the different parts of prayer? Here's a way to practice that.

- I. Remember that you are praying to the God of the Universe who is your daddy and loves you. Remember that He is so big and powerful that He has done many mighty things. Nothing is too hard for Him.
- P. Praise God that He hears your prayer. Praise Him that He is bigger than your need.
- R. Ask Him to remove any sins that might get in the way of your prayers. Ask Him to forgive the person you are praying for or bring them to repentance if they need it.
- A. Ask for healing or whatever blessing He puts on your heart for that person. Ask that His Kingdom come on earth as it is in Heaven for that person.
- Y. Thank Him for hearing and answering your prayers in His own time and in His own way. Pray for His will to be done in their lives.

Project Ideas

Make a P.O. Box (Praying for Others) The idea of the box is to invite others from your congregation or family to write their prayer requests on a card and "mail" them in the P.O. Box. The children can then take the cards out of the box and pray for those people.

We wrote these directions:

- 1. Write a prayer request on a card.
- 2. Drop the card in the box.
- 3. A Kingdom Kid will be praying for you!





Maybe follow up with a little note saying, "We prayed for you!"
