## Prayer Point Focus

### *Leader's Lesson Overview*

- Someone said that the Bible says not to fear 365 times. Once for every single day of the year. It seems to be important.
- Fear blocks God's blessings in our lives. And fear grows stronger the longer we allow it to stay.
- Fear is the opposite of faith.
- Keeping our eyes on Jesus and declaring His Word is the part of the Sword of the Spirit that fends off fear. Praise is the sledge hammer that knocks fear away!

Psalm 27:1 The Lord is my light and my salvation – whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life – of whom shall I be afraid?

### Prayers for the Church, Community and World

Be aware of needs in your church, community and even the world that need prayers. Remind the children how important prayers are. Pray for those that are hurting or need to find their shepherd.

Ask the children to quiet their hearts and minds and listen for the Spirit to tell them who or what to pray for.

## Lesson - Weapon Against Fear

See the Kids Gap book Pg 54. Talk about the story of Jehoshaphat and what he sent out in front of his army. "What can we do when we see a battle in our lives?" Remember Paul and Silas in prison? What did they do? Acts 16:25

PRAISE is a weapon against fear!

Children have so many things going on in their lives today. Ask them if there is something that they are afraid of or that is hard for them.

They might be afraid of going down to the basement.

They may be afraid of going to a new school.

Help them find a scripture to hang onto. Here are a couple good ones.

Isaiah 41:10 *Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God. (Don't be afraid. I am with you. Don't worry, I am your God.)*

Timothy 1:7 *For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. (God hasn't given us the spirit of fear. He gives power, love and good thoughts.)*



The name of Jesus is powerful against fear and praising God is also very powerful. Find a song or make a song from a scripture that you can sing when you are scared.

### CHALLENGE

The next time you are afraid, start singing or praising God at the top of your voice and watch fear vanish!!

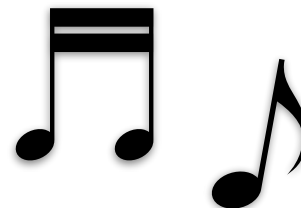

Here's an example

1. Identify a fear in your life.
2. Choose a scripture. What does it say?

Fear: Scary dreams : What do the scriptures say?

**Psalm 27:1, ESV** The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

3. Make a poster or card. Pray and say the scripture. Make it into a song to sing when you fall asleep. Every time you are afraid, praise God that you know He is bigger and stronger than fear. Sing or say praises to God and **kick fear out of the door!**

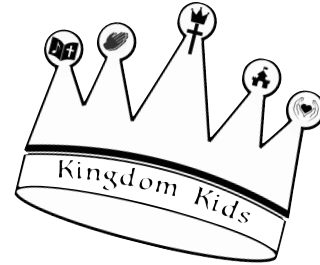
