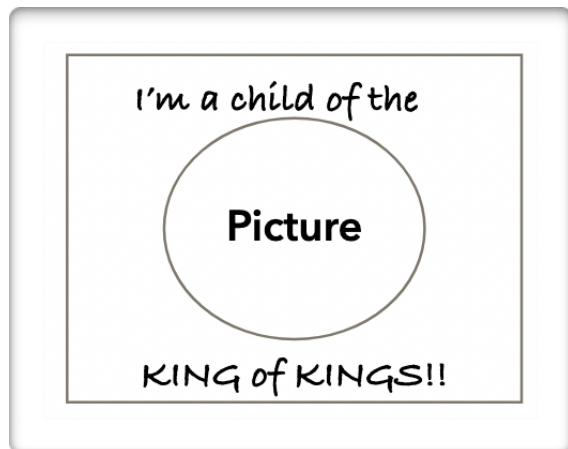
You belong to the King of Kings!

In His Love

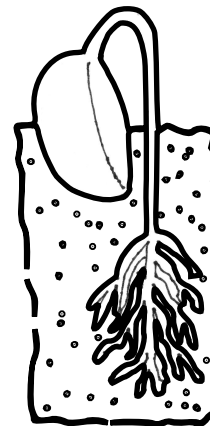
God's love

Ephesians 3:17-19

... That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to (understand how huge God's love is for you) comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God.

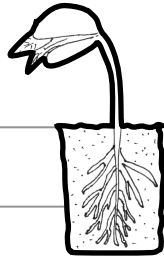

Prayer Point

- **We need to understand that God is our Father.** We are His children and He loves us very much.
- **Being rooted and grounded in love** means we will not be shaken or “blown over” when hard times come.
- **We grow deep and strong** by experiencing and acknowledging His love and care in our lives.



Prayers



- **If at church: Pray for the pastor and church service.** Have the pastor or pastorate meet with the children. Maybe the pastor could share a few prayer requests. Ask them to say a few words of encouragement, letting the children know how important their prayers are to the church and beyond.
- **If at home:** pray for your church and the leaders. Pray for those involved.
- **Encourage the children.** Tell them that God is using children all over the world to change history and they could be one of them!

Prayer Requests and Praise Reports

Spend some time asking children if they have needs to pray about or if they have some praise reports. Telling and hearing testimonies are so important for us all, to build our faith!

Rooted and Grounded Skit

Characters

1. Child (seen) 2. GOD (unseen)

Stage Setting: Child could sit on a chair and lean on a table that has a Bible on it.

Prop: real or artificial plant.

(CHILD: to audience - Shh! I'm trying to pray...)

bows head and folds hands

Child: Our Father, which art in Heaven...

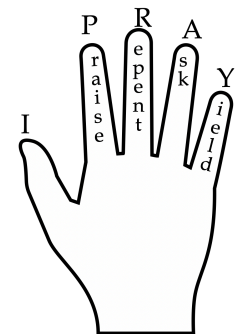
GOD: Here I am.

Child: Huh? Who's that?

GOD: Your father. Didn't you call me?

Put it into Practice

- Who is He? Who are you? This is the “I” of the Hand of Prayer. Knowing the King and being rooted and grounded is the seed of God’s spirit in you. As you pray and draw closer to God, that seed puts down roots in your heart.
- What are ways that God tells you that he loves you? Review the ways from the skit.
- You could go outside and notice all that God has created. Breathe in the air that He provides. Notice the tallest trees and yet the tiniest flowers and details.
