Give us this day our daily bread.


And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.

Prayer is Relationship

Matthew 6:9

- Prayer is is important. Look up III Nephi 8:50-52

Talk to the King - Discussion

How do you become friends with someone? You talk to them. Right? You probably spend a lot of time with them.

What do you talk about? Did you know that you can talk about those things with God?

Hi God! I have so much to talk to you about!

Explore Philippians 4:6

Be afflicted for nothing; but in **everything** by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Explore, Discuss and Practice

- Explore who YOU are. You are children, daughters, sons, students...
- Who are you to God? Beloved children of the King!
- Use the poster you made last time to remember who God and Jesus are.
- You could even add some more names of what God/Jesus are like (Provider, Comforter, Healer...) to the poster.
- Maybe you could picture sitting on God's lap like a father. Maybe He is so big that He has to pick you up and put you up on His shoulder. Just tell Him what is on your heart or just tell Him you love Him and want to get to know Him better!

Private Prayer Time

Practice some Private Prayer Time.

- If you're at home, find a cozy corner to pray. Look up ideas for a Prayer Closet.
- If you're at church, you can just bow your heads and have some quiet time. Maybe have some soft instrumental music playing in the background.
- Tell the kids that we are going to spend a little bit of time talking to God. You can talk about anything you want. Maybe you have a question for Him. Maybe you just want to tell Him you love him. Maybe you are sorry about something. Maybe you want to thank him for something.
- You will know when they get restless that the time is up. As you do this more often, the time the pray will be longer.
