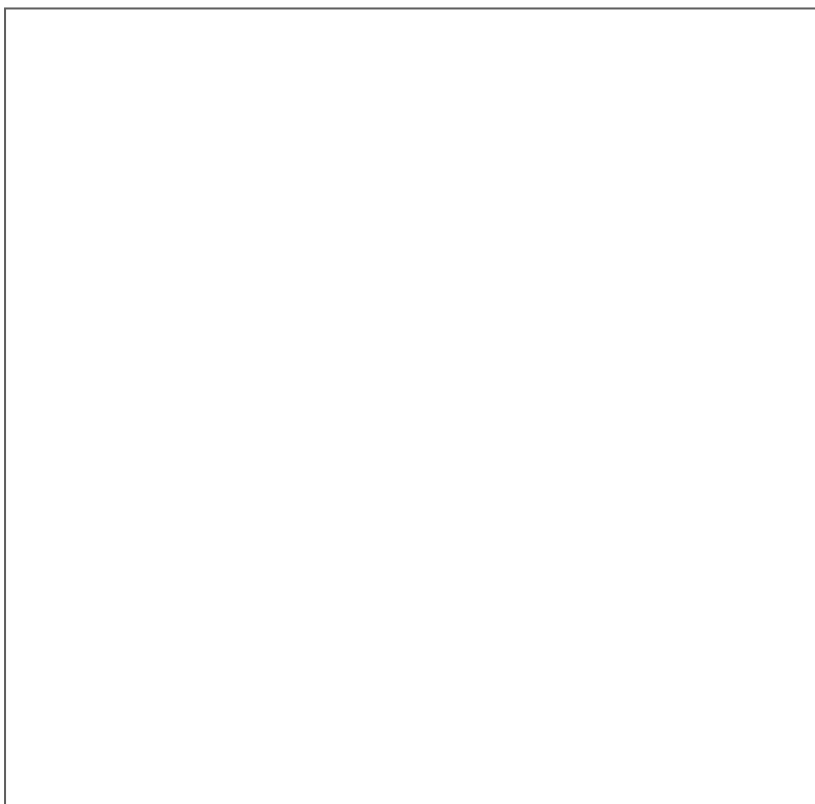


I repented of my sins

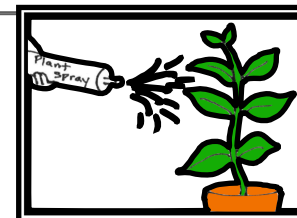


5. Repent

Forgive us our Trespasses

Matthew 6:13

*And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive
those that trespass against us*



It's God's righteousness that makes us clean.

On our own, we can never be righteous. But, we accept His stripes and His blood that washes us clean.

2 Corinthians 5:21

Repentance is a gift from a loving father!



- Continue with the Lord's Prayer focusing on **Forgive us our trespasses.**
- **Sin attacks God's plants.** Like bugs and disease, temptations and sins slowly destroy the plant of God's spirit. Weeds choke the plant and steal the nutrients from the soil.
- **Repentance is a wonderful gift!** It is asking the master gardener to pull the weeds in our hearts that have grown deep and we cannot remove on our own. A repentant heart is a joyful heart!

- **Encourage the children to pray specific prayers.**

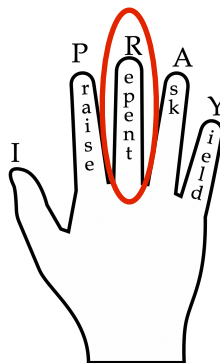
Prayer Point: Repent

- Use the story of the Prodigal Son or other stories from the scriptures about forgiveness.
- Share testimonies of repentance.

Use a raincoat and squirters or a shield and Nerf darts to illustrate being covered and uncovered by the Robe of Righteousness.

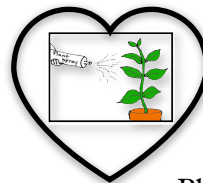


If you have planted a garden or plants together, this would be a good time to weed the garden and relate sins to bugs, weeds and diseases.

Pull the Weeds

God loves us so much, he wants to have a good relationship with us. When the garden of our hearts has too many weeds and bugs (negative thoughts, mean actions or words...) His Spirit can't flow through, like sap in a plant.

Repentance is a wonderful gift He has given. Jesus took our sins on the cross and all we have to do is turn away from our sins, ask Him to forgive us and He does! What a wonderful gift!



Pull some weeds and spray some bugs!

You could lead them in prayer like this:

“Father, I love you and want to have a clean heart. Please forgive me for _____...” (pause and then tell them to reach out and pull those imaginary weeds when they have prayed in their hearts.)

Now, praise God for his forgiveness!
